

The town board meeting was held on February 10, 2026 at the town justice building.

Councilman Voght led us in the pledge of allegiance.

Supervisor Bronner called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

The town clerk had forwarded the town clerk’s minutes to each board member to review before the meeting and copies of the minutes were given to the public to review before the meeting. This was done to save time as January minutes were very lengthy. Supervisor Bronner asked if any corrections, additions, or changes to the minutes. Councilman Valenta made motion to approve and Councilman Hubiak seconded. All approved.

Supervisor Bronner opened the meeting to the public at 7:03 pm. A question was asked about the cell tower. It is running and operational. There is no light at the top of the tower because it is not over 200 feet. No further discussion was brought up. Therefore, Supervisor Bronner proceeded with the regular meeting. The first order of business was the bond anticipation note renewal resolution for the Volvo truck. Basically authorizes Supervisor Bronner to make the first of five payments of \$60,000.00 principal payment plus interest payments. The renewal will be at 3.6% interest rate coming forward. Councilman Voght made motion for Supervisor to have authority to make the payment and Councilman Hubiak seconded. Roll call vote. All ayes. All approved .

Supervisor Bronner passed to the town board to review the real property tax services, sales tax revenue for the 1st quarter received, and 1st payment for plowing the county roads. Also was passed a new set of rules for tipping fees for garbage, construction, and etc. Supervisor Bronner had an item regarding the Otesquago Basin. Supervisor Bronner advised they will be contacting him in the near future as to possibly applying for a grant and if anything Connie Richards would be interested in.

A notice of requirement was passed to the town board to have the judge’s books audited. Councilman Voght and Councilman Valenta volunteered their services to audit the books.

The town attorney, Jerry Snyder, was at the meeting as paperwork for the reappointment of the registrar for the town of Stark, Eleanor Smith, needed to be filled out and notarized.

The town board reviewed the Supervisor’s report. Councilman Hubiak made motion to approve and Councilman Voght seconded. All approved.

The town board reviewed the town clerk's report consisting of one death certificate and one marriage certificate for the amount of \$20.00. Councilman Voght made motion to approve and Councilman Hubiak seconded. All approved.

The town board reviewed the General and Highway Fund vouchers to pay the bills. Councilman Hubiak made motion to pay the bills and Councilman Valenta seconded. All approved.

The next meeting will be held on March 10, 2026 at 7:00 pm. Councilman Hubiak made motion to adjourn and Councilman Valenta seconded. All approved. Meeting was adjourned at 7:50 pm.
